**The competition will be run under P.C. Eventing Rules 2024.**

**No pony may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £3 per rider to cover medical provision.**

### **Class 1. 60cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL COMBINED EVENTERS' CHALLENGE**

Entry fee: PC members £40, non-PC members £45

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Dressage Test: PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019.

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings, gloves must be worn. Whips are allowed.
- Jumping height 60cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 65cm 10 fences max and then straight onto the XC phase. Penalties will be as laid down in the PC Eventing Rulebook 2024 Section C Arena Eventing. Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.  
Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

### **Class 2. Dressage only competition**

Entry fee: Pony Club members: £20, Non-PC members £24

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings, gloves must be worn. Whips are allowed.

**No horse may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £3 per rider to cover medical provision.**

### **Class 3. 70cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL COMBINED EVENTERS' CHALLENGE**

Entry fee: PC members £40, non-PC members £45

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Dressage Test: Prelim PC70 2022

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings, gloves must be worn, whips may be carried.
- Show Jumping height 70cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 75cm and then straight onto the XC phase. Penalties will be as laid down in the PC Eventing Rulebook 2024 Section C Arena Eventing.

Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.

#### **Class 4 Dressage only competition**

Entry fee: Pony Club members: £20, Non-PC members £24

- Dressage Test: Prelim PC70 2022

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings, gloves must be worn, whips may be carried.

**No horse may be entered in more than one jumping class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £3 per rider to cover medical provision.**

#### **Class 5. 80cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL COMBINED EVENTERS' CHALLENGE**

Entry fee: PC members £40, non-PC members £45

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Dressage Test: Grassroots PC80 2018

At this competition the test may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.
- Show Jumping height 80cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 85cm. From SJ riders will go straight onto the XC phase. Penalties will be as laid down in the PC Eventing Rulebook 2024 Section C Arena Eventing.
- Cross Country. This phase will be timed in accordance with the 2024 PC Eventing rules.
- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.

#### **Class 6 Dressage only competition**

Entry fee: Pony Club £20, Non-PC members £24

At this competition the test may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.

## Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Correct riding attire in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Rules 2024 must be worn when mounted. Hats must be worn to the Pony Club specifications for 2024. Cross-country colours may be worn for the jumping phase and body protectors are compulsory. If you are wearing an air jacket, please abide by the Pony Club rules and if you have a body protector that requires a key, please ensure a spare is lodged with the secretary. The misuse of spurs, whips or any other items of tack causing discomfort to the horse may result in elimination, as will use of bad language.
- No ponies to be left tied to lorries/trailers, unattended.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day to try to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary for guidance regarding where to do this.
- The Organisers retain the right to retain £5.00 entry fee in the event of cancellation.
- Refunds will be given upon the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring. Objections can only be lodged by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their official representative.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead.
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay and take them home with you.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent and avoid accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, and all the Officials and Stewards.

INSURANCE: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Bisley & Sandown Chase Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
