Competitors may walk the course between 2pm -6pm on Saturday 27th April

In the event of adverse weather, a notice will be posted on our website, Area 13 FB page and www.ponyclubresults.co.uk Look out for community Watts App group to be created nearer the time.

Times will be published on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk by 6pm on Thursday 25th April.

The competition will be run under P.C. Eventing Rules 2024.

No horse may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two horses.

You must provide your own number bib and numbers – these can be printed by clicking your name on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk.

Class 1. 60cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL ODE

Entry fee: PC members £60, non-PC members £65

(any combination entering this class may not enter class 2 or 3)

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019.

 Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.
- Jumping height 60cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 65cm
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.
- Show Jumping will take place before the Cross Country. Competitors eliminated Show Jumping or having incurred more than 24 jumping faults will not be allowed to go Cross Country.
- Cross Country. Competitors are eliminated for 3 refusals at any one jump or 4 refusals over whole course. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

No horse may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two horses.

Class 2, 70cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL ODE

Entry fee: PC members £60, non-PC members £65

(any combination entering this class may not enter Class 1 or 3)

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: Prelim PC70 2022

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.

- Jumping height 70cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 75cm
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.
- Show Jumping will take place before the Cross Country. Competitors eliminated Show Jumping or having incurred more than 24 jumping faults will not be allowed to go Cross Country.
- Cross Country. Competitors are eliminated for 3 refusals at any one jump or 4 refusals over whole course. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

No horse may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two horses.

Class 3. 80cm TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL ODE

Entry fee: PC members £60, non-PC members £65

(any combination entering this class may not enter Class 1 or 2)

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: Grassroots PC80 2018

 At this competition the test may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.
- Jumping height 80cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 85cm
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.
- Show Jumping will take place before the Cross Country. Competitors eliminated Show Jumping or having incurred more than 24 jumping faults will not be allowed to go Cross Country.
- Cross Country. This phase will be timed in accordance with the 2024 PC Eventing rules. Competitors are eliminated for 3 refusals at any one jump or 4 refusals over whole course. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Correct riding attire in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Rules 2024 must be worn when mounted. Hats must be worn to the Pony Club specifications for 2024. A body protector, to the Pony Club specifications is compulsory for the cross-country phase and is recommended for showjumping. Body protectors may be worn outside jackets for all disciplines. If you are wearing an air jacket, please abide by the Pony Club rules and if you have a body protector that requires a key, please ensure a spare is lodged with the secretary. The misuse of spurs, whips or any other items of tack causing discomfort to the horse may result in elimination, as will use of bad language.
- No ponies to be left tied to lorries/trailers unattended.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day to try to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary for guidance regarding where to do this.
- The Organisers retain the right to retain £5.00 entry fee in the event of cancellation.
- Refunds will be given upon the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring. Objections can only be lodged by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their official representative.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead.
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay and take them home with you.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent and avoid accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, and all the Officials and Stewards.

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

INSURANCE: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Bisley & Sandown Chase Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
